

QUAIL VALLEY ESTATES OWNERS ASSOCIATION POOL RULES

Effective May 2004

The Swimming Pool exists for the use of Quail Valley residents and their guests only. Common sense, courtesy and consideration for others should be the only rules necessary to guarantee your enjoyment of the Association's swimming pool facilities. However, to protect your rights from the occasional offender, these rules exist. Any Quail Valley resident can enforce the rules, and should report offenders to the Pool Monitor or to the Association's Property Manager, Associations Communications, Inc. at (925) 672-2221 that the Association can take further appropriate action. ***IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ALL QUAIL VALLEY RESIDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS TO KNOW AND FOLLOW ALL THE RULES LISTED BELOW.*** Use of the pool is a privilege, not a right, and pool privileges may be suspended for failure to comply with the Swimming Pool Rules.

The Pool Monitor or other authorized agent of the Association may close the pool at any time without notice for rules violations or hazardous conditions.

No one will be allowed into the Pool Area without his or her own authorized Picture Pool ID issued by the Association AND their pool key. If you did not come to the pool with this ID or your keys, you must get them before entering the Pool Area. Keys and Photo Pool ID's are not transferable and are subject to revocation if loaned to anyone else. The Pool Area is the entire area inside the pool gate.

1. All residents are required to temporarily surrender their Picture Pool ID card to the officer upon entry into the Pool Area. Cards will be returned upon exiting the pool area, provided there are no problems.
2. No one under the age of 14 is allowed to use the pool facilities unless accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult resident, 18 years of age or older.
3. Everyone 14 and older must have a Picture Pool ID.
4. Each household is permitted a maximum of two (2) guests in the Pool Area at any one time. Guests must be accompanied at all times, by a responsible adult resident, 18 years or older. Guests are required to sign in. It is up to the discretion of the Pool Monitor to allow more than two guests.
5. No formal gatherings or parties will be permitted at the pool.
6. Only authorized individuals are allowed in the pool equipment shed. No adjustment of the temperature or other controls may be made by anyone not authorized.
7. Safety equipment, including the life ring, is not to be used except in case of an emergency.
8. Pets are not allowed in the Pool Area under any circumstances. (California State Law, Health & Safety Code)
9. No person who is ill, injured, or has an open wound is permitted in the pool. (California State Law, Health & Safety Code)
10. Proper swimming attire is required, no cutoffs or street clothes. No shoes may be worn in the water (water socks are ok).
11. No hair clips, hoop earrings, bobby pins are allowed in the pool.
12. Persons under 3 years old must wear plastic pants over cloth diapers or approved "swim diapers" when in the pool. Disposable diapers are not permitted. No unclothed person permitted. Non-swimmers should wear an approved flotation device when in the Pool Area.
13. **ALL SWIMMERS MUST SHOWER PRIOR TO SWIMMING AND UPON RE-ENTERING POOL.**
14. Diving into the pool is unsafe and not permitted. No running, "horseplay", profanity, fighting, boisterous or rowdy behavior is permitted in the Pool Area. Activities that may be dangerous or disturbing to others are prohibited. Violators are subject to loss of pool privileges.
